

General Terms and Conditions for participation in the "Milipol&Cartes 2015 International business meetings"

1. Object

These General Terms and Conditions constitute a contract that governs the relationship between the CCI Paris Ile-de-France, member of Enterprise Europe Network ("the Organiser") and the Participant for the international B2B meetings "Milipol&Cartes 2015 business meetings".

In the event of any individual provisions of these General Terms and Conditions are invalid or become invalid in the future, the validity of other provisions shall not be affected. The provision turned ineffective shall be replaced by an effective provision that reflects closest the purpose desired.

2. Services

For the purpose of "Milipol&Cartes Business meetings 2015", the CCI Paris Ile-de-France collects cooperation offers and requests in an on-line catalogue and organises 3 days of international B2B meetings for the visitors and the exhibitors. This event "Milipol&Cartes International business meetings" will take place from November 17th, 2015 to November 19th and is a part of the Milipol and Cartes 2015 exhibition which is organized by Comexposium from November 17th to November 20th at the Paris Nord Villepinte exhibition center.

The event is targeted at SMEs, Research institutes, academic institutions, Start-up companies and Public bodies from all over Europe and beyond and which are looking for partnerships.

The Organiser offers the Participants to have their contact details and company profiles added to a database set up by Converve. The objective is to facilitate business contacts with other users of the database, by organizing bilateral meetings.

3. Registration Procedure

The participants must register at the following website until November 3rd, 2015:

The participant must fill in a short profile to describe his organisation and a cooperation profile, what the company is offering or looking for.

The participant must agree to provide accurate, current and complete information as prompted by the registration form ("Profile"). The user name is the e-mail address and the participant must select a password to have access to the data. All entries will be checked and validated by the Organiser before being included in the catalogue. All fields must be completed in English and some are mandatory (*).

For each type of collaboration sought (e.g. technical cooperation agreement, joint venture, commercial alliance, etc) a new cooperation profile must be submitted. Furthermore, each profile can be assigned to a different representative within your organization.

If information is missing or unclear, the Organizer will contact the Participant. Profiles which are incomplete, unclear or not relevant to the event will not be included in the catalogue. Once registered, the Participant will receive an email to acknowledge the participation request. The participant will receive his business agenda before November 17th 2015. Participant agrees to honor the appointment he has accepted or requested during the Event. If the participant fails to meet its pre-scheduled appointments, the organiser reserves the right to cancel all his planning. In this case no refund will be made by the organiser.

4. Participation fee

4.1. Price of the participation

The exhibitors pay no mandatory registration fee for the Milipol&Cartes Business meetings

The Visitors pay a mandatory registration fee of: 250 euros per business schedule (300 euros including VAT).

The fee is fixed for one registration per company profile registered and per business schedule for the "Milipol&Cartes 2015 Business meetings" which last three days. It includes one free entrance to Milipol&Cartes Exhibition with electronic badge for the day(s) of the scheduled meetings as pre-registered visitor.

4.2. Means of Payment

7. Registration control by Comexposium

According to Milipol&Cartes 2015 Terms and Conditions, a company registration may be reviewed according to matters such as the compatibility of the applicant’s activities with the nomenclature of the exhibition.

Comexposium, as the Milipol&Cartes 2015 Exhibition organizer, reserves the right to accept or reject applications at its discretion. The Organizer of the “Milipol&Cartes 2015 International business meetings” event shall not be held liable for any losses in case that the exhibition organizer rejects an application.

In case of an application being rejected by Comexposium, the payment will be entirely refunded according to the conditions provided in article 6.2 of the present terms.

8. Confidentiality

The Organizer shall not disclose any information communicated by the participant without his express agreement. The provision does not apply to information which is already in the Public domain.

The participant’s personal data will be transmitted to Comexposium, organizer of the Milipol&Cartes exhibition and partner of the Milipol&Cartes 2015 Business meetings, only for the purpose of Milipol&Cartes 2015 exhibition (sending news, registration process as visitor ...).

Information communicated by the participant may be used by the Organizer for the publication of an anonymous profile in the Enterprise Europe Network database for the purpose of partnerships research.

9. Property rights of Data

The Organizer remains the sole holder of property rights and rights to economic exploitation of inventions and programs (including software, documentation and written programs, studies, etc.) and whatever else was prepared, realized, or developed by means of the services provided for the Milipol&Cartes Business meetings.

10. Force majeure

The Organizer shall not be liable to the Participant in any manner or be deemed to be in breach of the present terms because of any delay in performing or any failure to perform any of the Organizer’s obligations under the present terms if the delay or failure was due to an “Event of Force Majeure” or any cause beyond the Organizer reasonable control.

The organizer shall not be liable in case Milipol and Cartes 2015 exhibition will be cancelled by Comexposium, or in case of any other breach of the present terms due to Comexposium.

For the purposes of the present terms, an “Event of Force Majeure” shall include natural disasters, riots, war, strikes, lock-outs or other industrial disputes, epidemics, failure of telecommunication and transportation systems, failure of the world wide web, governmental restraints and act(s) of legislature or any other cause whether similar or dissimilar to any of the causes described in this section.

11. Governing Law and court of jurisdiction

All these terms and conditions shall be governed by the French law. In Case of any dispute arising in connections with these terms and conditions, the place of jurisdiction shall be Paris, France.
